The wind on a bright but blustery February 22nd did not deter more than 80 people from celebrating the groundbreaking for the CarePartners Rehabilitation Hospital Expansion. CarePartners board members and staff were joined by architects and builders, former patients and others excited to kick off construction of this eagerly awaited project.

Chat Norvell, CarePartners President and CEO, welcomed our guests. Kerry Friedman, CarePartners Health Services Board Chair and Joel Rosenberg, M.D., CarePartners Foundation Board Chair, spoke on the need for the expansion and the role of the Foundation in seeing the \$8.5 million project to fruition.

Today, the hospital has only 38 rooms. With a current average of 60 patients each day, many patients must share a room and may need to be moved during their stay.

The expansion will add 17 new private patient rooms, bringing the total number of rooms to 55. The private rooms will provide a quieter and more restful atmosphere, encourage greater family involvement, and allow patients to converse freely and confidentially with doctors, nurses and visitors.

Expansion At a Glance

- 17 new private patient rooms, bringing the total to 55 rooms
- New 2,500 square foot therapy pavilion and speech and occupational therapy suites on the same level as patient rooms
