- CPF has granted \$1,049,103 in community support to local organizations since 2008.
- During the past ten years CPF has provided \$543,337 in scholarship support for local high school, AB Tech, and UNC Asheville students pursuing a degree in healthcare.
- Over the past ten years CarePartners Foundation has disbursed more than \$20,071,396 in support of CarePartners Health Services operations.
- In 2015, we provided all funding to open the first Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) in Western North Carolina.
- Our \$20 million investment in capital projects over the past ten years includes the CarePartners Hospice Solace Center, PACE building, Rehabilitation Hospital renovations, and the Orthotics and Prosthetics building.
- CPF is governed by a volunteer board of directors.
